**A Conversation with Dr. Estela Bensimon:
Strategies for Attaining Equity in Higher Education**

You are invited to a workshop led by Dr. Estela Bensimon, Professor of Higher Education and Co-Director of the Center for Urban Education at the USC Rossier School of Education, on increasing capacity to use institutional data to improve college completion among underserved student populations.
